3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Capitol Remembrance

5 Act".

2 SEC. 2. EXHIBIT DEPICTING THE ATTACK ON THE CAPITOL. 2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 2 years after the 3 date of enactment of this Act, the Architect of the Capitol, in consultation with the Joint Committee on the Library, 4 5 shall carry out a project to design and install in a prominent location in the United States Capitol a permanent 6 7 exhibit that depicts the attack on the Capitol that occurred 8 on January 6, 2021. 9 (b) Exhibit Requirements.— 10 (1) Inclusion of Capitol Property.—The 11 Architect shall, to the extent practicable, preserve 12 property from the United States Capitol or the 13 United States Capitol Grounds (as described in sec-14 tion 5102 of title 40, United States Code) that was damaged during the attack and include such prop-15 16 erty in the exhibit described in subsection (a) as the 17 Architect determines appropriate. 18 (2) Photographic records.—The Architect 19 shall include existing photographic records relating 20 to the attack on the Capitol in the exhibit described 21 in subsection (a). 22

- (3) PLAQUE.—The Architect shall include in the exhibit described in subsection (a) a plaque for the purpose of honoring—
