This Act may be cited as the "Averting Loss of Life
and Injury by Expediting SIVs Act of 2021" or as the
"Allies Act of 2021".

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# 1SEC. 2. IMPROVING AFGHAN SPECIAL IMMIGRANT VISA2PROGRAM.

3 (a) EVIDENCE OF SERIOUS THREAT.—Section
4 602(b)(2) of the Afghan Allies Protection Act of 2009 (8
5 U.S.C. 1101 note) is amended—

6 (1) by striking subparagraph (E); and

7 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (F) as sub-8 paragraph (E).

9 (b) ACTIVITIES FOR UNITED STATES MILITARY PER-10 SONNEL STATIONED AT INTERNATIONAL SECURITY As-11 SISTANCE FORCE.—Section 602(b)(2)(A)(ii)(II)(bb) of 12 the Afghan Allies Protection Act of 2009 (8 U.S.C. 1101 13 note) is amended by striking "sensitive and trusted".

14 (c) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by this section shall apply to any application for a special immi-15 grant visas under the Afghan Allies Protection Act of 16 2009 (8 U.S.C. 1101 note) that are pending on the date 17 of the enactment of this Act or filed on or after such date. 18 19 (d) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—The amendments 20made by this section shall not diminish, replace or override 21 any vetting, verification of employment, approval by chief 22 of mission, or any other screening process required for a 23 special immigrant visa under the Afghan Allies Protection

24 Act of 2009 (8 U.S.C. 1101 note).

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## SEC. 3. ADDITIONAL AFGHAN SPECIAL IMMIGRANT VISA ALLOTMENT.

3 Section 602(b)(3) of the Afghan Allies Protection Act
4 of 2009 (8 U.S.C. 1101 note) is amended by adding at
5 the end the following:

6 "(G) SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEARS.—Begin-7 ning on the date of the enactment of this sub-8 paragraph, in addition to any unused balance 9 under this paragraph, 8,000 principal aliens may be granted special immigrant status under 10 11 this subsection. For purposes of status provided 12 under this subparagraph the authority to issue 13 visas shall commence on the date of the enact-14 ment of this subparagraph and shall terminate 15 on the date such visas are exhausted.".
