To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide that a Member of Congress convicted of certain felony offenses relating to sexual abuse shall not be eligible for retirement benefits based on that individual's Member service, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Congress Leadership  
5       in Ending Annuities for Dishonorable Service Act” or the  
6       “Congress LEADS Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FORFEITURE OF CSRS OR FERS ANNUITY BASED ON**  
2 **SERVICE AS A MEMBER OF CONGRESS AFTER**  
3 **CONVICTION OF FELONY SEXUAL ABUSE.**

4 (a) CIVIL SERVICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—Section  
5 8332(o)(2) of title 5, United States Code, is amended—

6 (1) in subparagraph (A)(iii)—

7 (A) by striking “or” at the end of sub-  
8 clause (I);

9 (B) by striking the period at the end of  
10 subclause (II) and inserting “; or”; and

11 (C) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(III) is committed after the date of enact-  
13 ment of the Congress Leadership in Ending An-  
14 nuities for Dishonorable Service Act and is de-  
15 scribed in subparagraph (B)(xxxii).”; and

16 (2) in subparagraph (B), by adding at the end  
17 the following:

18 “(xxxii) An offense under chapter 109A of title  
19 18 (relating to sexual abuse).”.

20 (b) FEDERAL EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—  
21 Section 8411(l)(2)(C) of title 5, United States Code, is  
22 amended by striking the period at the end and inserting  
23 the following: “, or, in the case of an offense described  
24 in section 8332(o)(2)(B)(xxxii), after the date of enact-  
25 ment of the Congress Leadership in Ending Annuities for  
26 Dishonorable Service Act.”.

1       (c) APPLICATION.—For purposes of applying section  
2 8332(o) or 8411(l) of title 5, United States Code, the  
3 amendments made by this section shall apply to any act  
4 or omission occurring after the date of enactment of this  
5 Act.
