## A BILL

### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Global War on Ter-

5 rorism Memorial Location Act"

#### 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.

7 Congress finds the following:

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1 (1) Nearing two decades after the September 2 11 attacks against the United States, America con-3 tinues the Global War on Terrorism, at great per-4 sonal cost to men and women serving on active duty 5 in the nation's Armed Forces and to those whose 6 support they depend upon to fulfill their duties. 7 (2) Civil servants from federal agencies, the intelligence community, local emergency responders, 8 9 and other civilian support personnel have made sig-10 nificant sacrifices in their service in the Global War 11 on Terrorism. 12 (3) Honoring the losses endured by these indi-13 viduals and their families, in 2017 Congress unani-14 mously passed and the President signed Public Law 15 115–51, which allowed the Global War on Terrorism 16 Memorial Foundation to establish a memorial to the 17 fallen on Federal land in the District of Columbia. 18 (4) Given the significance of the Global War on 19 Terrorism as the longest-running conflict in United 20 States history and the magnitude of the sacrifice in-21 volved in these operations, it is appropriate to locate 22 the memorial to the Global War on Terrorism within 23 the Reserve alongside existing memorials to the na-24 tion's major armed conflicts.

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# SEC. 3. NATIONAL GLOBAL WAR ON TERRORISM MEMORIAL LOCATION.

3 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Notwithstanding section
4 8908(c) of title 40, United States Code, the Global War
5 on Terrorism Memorial Foundation may establish a Na6 tional Global War on Terrorism Memorial within the Re7 serve.

8 (b) LOCATION.—The Memorial shall be located at one 9 of the following sites, as identified in and consistent with 10 the document known as "The Memorials and Museums 11 Master Plan":

12 (1) Potential Site 1 – Constitution Gardens,
13 Prime Candidate Site 10 in The Memorials and Mu14 seums Master Plan.

15 (2) Potential Site 2 – JFK Hockey Fields,
16 Prime Candidate Site 18 in The Memorials and Mu17 seums Master Plan.

18 (3) Potential Site 3 – West Potomac Park,
19 Candidate Site 70 in The Memorials and Museums
20 Master Plan.

(c) COMMEMORATIVE WORKS ACT.—Except as otherwise provided by subsections (a) and (b), chapter 89 of
title 40, United States Code (commonly known as the
"Commemorative Works Act"), shall apply to the Memorial.

(d) DEFINITIONS.—For the purposes of this section,
 the following definitions apply—

3 (1) MEMORIAL.—The term "Memorial" means
4 the National Global War on Terrorism Memorial au5 thorized by subsection (a).

6 (2) RESERVE.—The term "Reserve" has the
7 meaning given that term in 8902(a)(3) of title 40,
8 United States Code.
