Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Workforce Training Center Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Adams County, located at 4430 South Adams County Parkway, Brighton, CO 80601. The funding would be used for supporting the development of a workforce training facility in Adams County, which will have the capacity to train 200 Coloradans a year through an evidence-based, no-cost training program which has already seen over 900 graduates. The project has a Federal nexus because Colorado has a deficit of qualified workers across many sectors, including healthcare, the skilled trades, transportation, and emerging green sectors of the labor market. Across the Denver metro region, more than 350,000 people live in economic poverty, and many are looking to train or retrain into jobs that pay a living wage in these high-demand sectors.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
