I am requesting funding for the Havana Street Corridor Multimodal Improvement Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Aurora, located at 15151 E. Alameda Parkway, Aurora, CO 80012. The funding would be used for widening sidewalks, improving bus stops, and improving lighting along Havana Street in Aurora, CO. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because Havana Street is one of the most important and highly used transit corridors in Aurora. The project is the result of 73 strategies focusing on pedestrian/bicycle, transit, vehicle, and land use & branding improvements. An estimated 21,000 households live within half a mile of the Havana Street corridor and have rates of zero vehicle ownership and low-income status at rates higher than average.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133(b).
