I am requesting funding for the Montview Blvd Complete Streets Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Aurora, located at 15151 E. Alameda Parkway, Aurora, CO 80012. The funding would be used for transforming the thoroughfare into a 5-lane section, with 3 lanes in the Central Green area, while adding new traffic signals at Racine and Victor intersections and installing Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) at Scranton, Ursula, and Uvalda crossings. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because these enhancements will benefit bus users, campus shuttle passengers, motorists, and pedestrians alike, creating a safer, more accessible, and aesthetically pleasing environment for all. Montview Blvd serves many different individuals in this area, including students from the University of Colorado, medical staff affiliated with CU Medicine, the Aurora Police Department at District 1, and the Aurora Health Authority, among others. Additionally, the upgraded pedestrian components will be a benefit to the Aurora Public Schools, RTD users, and those visiting the campus as a patient.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133(b).
