I am requesting funding for the Center for Nursing Health and Public Service Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Community College of Aurora, located at 16000 E Centrectech Pkwy, Aurora, CO 8001. The funding would be used for costs associated with renovating and retrofitting the Center for Nursing, Health Sciences and Public Service Center, providing the furniture, fixtures, and equipment necessary for hands-on nursing, health sciences, fire sciences, and paramedic/EMS classrooms, simulation labs, and student collaboration spaces. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide on-site, responsive, shorter-term, industry-specific training addressing staffing shortages felt by medical facilities and helping address healthcare disparities in the community. The Center will strengthen the economic development and workforce training ecosystem of the region by supporting thousands of residents annually gaining skills, credentials, and degrees for employment and economic mobility in healthcare fields.
