## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to prohibit the establishment of a corporation to conceal election contributions and donations by foreign nationals.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Shell Company Abuse
- 5 Act".

- 2 (a) In General.—Chapter 29 of title 18, United

- 8 "(a) Offense.—It shall be unlawful for an owner,
