RE: Colorado Boulevard and Euclid Avenue Roundabout Safety Improvement Project

Dear Representative Crow,

On behalf of the City of Centennial, I am writing to express strong support for the City's Fiscal Year 2027 Community Project Funding request for the Colorado Boulevard and Euclid Avenue Roundabout Safety Improvement Project.

The intersection of Colorado Boulevard and Euclid Avenue experiences significant congestion and vehicle turning conflicts, particularly during school arrival and dismissal periods when traffic volumes increase and pedestrian activity is high. These conditions create safety challenges for drivers, pedestrians, and especially students walking or biking to nearby schools.

The City proposes to convert the existing intersection into a modern single-lane roundabout to improve safety and traffic operations. Roundabouts are widely recognized as one of the most effective intersection safety treatments because they slow vehicle speeds and reduce the number of conflict points between vehicles.

By replacing the current intersection configuration with a roundabout, the project will significantly reduce the potential for severe crashes while improving pedestrian safety. The design will include ADA-compliant sidewalks and crossings, improved signage and pavement markings, and enhanced roadway geometry that encourages safer driving behavior.

In addition to safety improvements, the roundabout will improve traffic flow during peak travel periods. Continuous vehicle movement through the intersection will reduce delays and congestion associated with school drop-off and pick-up times, benefiting both local residents and families traveling to nearby schools.

The City respectfully requests \$2.3 million in Community Project Funding to support construction of this critical safety improvement. Federal investment in this project will
