I am requesting funding for the Laredo Elementary Revitalization project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for the project is Adams-Arapahoe 28-J School District located at 15701 E 1<sup>st</sup> Ave, Aurora, Colorado, 80011.

The funding would be used to support demolition of the outdated Laredo Elementary building, environmental cleanup of the site, and transformation of the space into a safe outdoor learning and recreation space. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because transformation of the outdated building into a learning and recreation space will provide students with safe, engaging opportunities for hands-on learning and play, benefitting some 400 students annually. The project also strengthens community cohesion and provides a lasting community asset that enhances overall quality of life for families across the district.
