I am requesting funding for the Gun Club South Infrastructure Expansion project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for the project is Arapahoe County located at 5334 Prince Street, Littleton, Colorado, 80120.

The funding would be used to reconstruct a 1.5-mile segment of Gun Club Road east of E-470 between Quincy Avenue and Aurora Parkway. The funding will specifically support the construction of the roadway widening, the multimodal path system, and intersection improvements that enhance safety and access for all users. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the reconstruction of the roadway will result in improved mobility, reduced congestion, enhanced emergency response and evacuation capacity, and increased transportation resilience.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
