I am requesting funding for the Aurora Navigation Campus Roof Replacement project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for the project is the City of Aurora located at 15151 E Alameda Pkwy, Ste 5800, Aurora, CO, 80012.

The funding would be used to assist in the replacement of, and repairs to, the roof of the Aurora Regional Navigation Campus. Through a public-private partnership with Advance Pathways, this facility utilizes a tiered system to provide shelter for people experiencing homelessness in Aurora and across the region. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the Campus supports unhoused individuals in the City of Aurora, as well as Adams, Arapahoe, and Douglas counties, as well as surrounding municipalities and rural communities. Components of the roof have been determined to be at the end of their useful life. If the City is unable to replace and repair the roof, any disruption in the services provided at the Campus would be detrimental to the populations served and the surrounding region.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(4).
