Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Broadway Intersections Safety and Multimodal Improvements project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for the project is the City of Littleton located at 2255 West Berry Ave, Littleton, Colorado, 80120.

The funding would be used to construct safety and multimodal improvements at the intersections of South Broadway with Littleton Boulevard and Mineral Avenue. Among the improvements anticipated are intersection geometry modifications, upgraded pedestrian crossings with ADA-compliant curb ramps, signal and traffic control upgrades, and bicycle facility enhancements. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because these safety and multimodal improvements will reduce crashes and improve pedestrian, bicycle, and transit access along a major regional corridor. A 2023 study by the City identified both intersections as high-injury network and bottleneck locations.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
