I am requesting funding for the Mobile Assistance Centers project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for the project is the City of Littleton located at 2255 West Berry Avenue, Littleton, Colorado, 80120.

The funding would be used to purchase one high-ceiling electric vehicle, retrofit this vehicle and two already-secured electric vans, and other associated costs. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the Mobile Assistance Centers will be used to connect low-income community members with workforce development opportunities and provide resources that are vital for families who want to work but may face barriers to entering and remaining in the workforce, including housing and childcare. These centers will also support disaster recovery and response, enabling impacted communities to stabilize efficiently.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1).
