I am requesting funding for the Littleton Public Schools ADA Accessible Restroom Initiative project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for the project is Arapahoe County School District #6 located at 5776 South Crocker Street, Littleton, Colorado, 80120.

The funding would be used to complete an ADA accessibility project to upgrade a restroom in one elementary school in the Littleton Public Schools system, including for the expansion of an existing restroom and the purchase of necessary equipment like adult-sized motorized changing tables and ceiling-track lift systems. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because these upgrades will ensure that students can attend to their personal needs with dignity and safety, protect staff from injury, and remove barriers that may prevent full-day school attendance by members of the school community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
