- December 31: Nominations Submitted to Academies


Average student profile

- Almost half are in top 10% of class
- 60-70% are in National Honor Society
- 90% awarded Athletic Letter
- Avg. SAT: Math 669, Read 656
- Avg. ACT: Math 29, Read 31, Eng 30, Sci 30
- Majority involved in student gov, leadership programs and/or community service
- Approx. 50% of qualified applicants granted a nomination
- 8-20% of applicants will be admitted

After the interviews

- Panel members and staff score and rank candidates
- Present recommendations to the Congressman who makes final decisions
- Use the Competitive Nomination system choose up to 10 qualified candidates per vacancy and let the Service Academy admissions team choose
